





HISTORY OF CONSTITUTION DAY

Constitution Day also known as "National Law Day", is celebrated in India on 26 November every year to commemorate the adoption of the Constitution of India. On 26 November 1949, the Constituent Assembly of India adopted to the Constitution of India, and it came into effect on 26 January 1950. The Prime Minister of India Narendra Modi made the declaration on 11 October 2015 while laying the foundation stone of the B. R. Ambedkar's Statue of Equality memorial in Mumbai. The year of 2021 was the 131th birth anniversary of Ambedkar, who had chaired the drafting committee of the Constituent Assembly and played a pivotal role in the drafting of the constitution. Previously this day was celebrated as Law Day. 26 November was chosen to spread the importance of the constitution and to spread thoughts and ideas of Ambedkar.

SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM

The Preamble gives guidance and states the purpose for which the Constitution of India is framed. It encapsulates the fundamental objectives of the Constitution. The Preamble usually sets out the main aim which a particular legislation is intends to achieve. The whole objective of the preamble is to design and deliver specific facts which need to be explained and recited so as to understand the basic objective and purpose of a statute.
