We encourage our students to participate in national and International Hackthon, Gameathon, tackathon etc. Students were also encouraged to participate in social awareness programs like Marathon and NSS camps.

Action taken during the assessment year 2022-23

- Induction program for the newly admitted students for the batch of 2022-23 was held in
 the College campus between 1-12-2022 to 9-12-2022. This was done in accordance to the
 guidelines of the VTU. Programs on Universal Human Values, Importance of Yoga,
 Importance of Physical Activities Introduction to various branches Personality development
 program was done for the benefit of the Students.
- 2. A **personality development Program** for the I sem Students batch of 22-23 was conducted by the Training and Placement Cell of KSIT on 23-01-2023 to 27-01-2023
- 3. A **Science Fest** was organized by the Department of AS&H "Latest innovation and advances in science, technology and its importance" on 17-3-2023. The students exhibited their talents by creating working mini project, Poster presentation, photography, pick & speak and debate.
- 4. All departments will be arranging various Technical talks, workshops, Seminars and club oriented programs. In the academic year 2022-23 there are 35 Technical talks, 8 workshops, 6 Seminars and 4 club events.
