HISTORY OF INDEPENDENCE DAY

On August 15, 1947, the first prime minister of India, Jawaharlal Nehru, raised the Indian national flag above the Lahori Gate of Red Fort in Delhi. It is a tradition that has since been followed by every Prime Minister with an address to the country.












Warm up exercises were taken and all the students practiced & performed sitting and standing asanas, importance of these


were explained simultaneously. The instructor encouraged students to practice regular yoga to remain fit and improve concentration.

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
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
