- To foster community involvement and social responsibility through participation in blood donation.
- To motivate past donors to donate regularly for a continuous blood supply.
- To Honor regular and voluntary donors with recognition to encourage loyalty and advocacy.

# **SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM**

The blood donation camp at K S Institute of Technology, organized in collaboration with the Red Cross Society and the Rotaract Club, was a significant success. Students, faculty members, and NSS volunteers actively participated, contributing to a substantial blood collection. This initiative aimed to raise awareness about the importance of blood donation and support local hospitals and patients in need.
