OBJECTIVES:

1. To educate participants about the harmful effects of drug abuse.
2. To promote a healthy and drug-free lifestyle.
3. To strengthen collaboration between colleges and law enforcement.
4. To empower students to resist peer pressure and make informed choices.
5. To encourage peer support in preventing drug abuse.
6. To spread awareness to the wider community about drug prevention.

SCOPE OF THE EVENT:

The Drug Awareness Program aimed to educate students, NSS volunteers, and the general public about the serious dangers of drug abuse while promoting a drug-free and healthy lifestyle for long-term well-being. This initiative facilitated collaboration between the Talagattapura Police Station and nearby educational institutions, creating a united front to effectively address drug-related issues and challenges. The program empowered participants with the knowledge and confidence to make informed decisions, spread critical awareness within their communities, and encourage peer support systems to combat drug abuse collectively.

By highlighting the importance of combating drug abuse, it sought to inspire students, youth, and the public to contribute to a ripple effect, fostering a healthier, safer, and more responsible society.

HIGHLIGHTS OF THE EVENT:

On 30th November 2024, a Drug Awareness Program (Drugs Muktha Bangalore) was organized by the Talagattapura Police Station in collaboration with Smitham NGO at Avalahalli, Konanakunte. The event witnessed the participation of NSS volunteers from KSIT and nearby colleges, all working together to raise awareness about drug abuse and its harmful consequences.

The program commenced at 5:30 PM with an insightful address by the Police Commissioner, who emphasized the dangers of drug usage and the importance of collective efforts in eradicating this issue. This was followed by a detailed talk by the police marshals of Talagattapura Police Station, focusing on the legal framework prohibiting drug use and the devastating effects of substance abuse. The President of Smitham NGO also spoke passionately about the ways to overcome drug addiction and shared strategies for raising awareness among peers and the community to combat this menace. A significant highlight of the event was a rally conducted through the streets of Avalahalli. Volunteers carried torches in their hands and marched with enthusiasm, using placards and posters designed by students from various colleges to convey strong messages about the dangers of drugs. The rally aimed to educate the youth and the public, creating a visible impact in the community.

Volunteers were provided with event-themed T-shirts advocating the message to stop drug usage, which added to the unity and spirit of the program. Toward the end of the event, the police marshals and NGO members led all the participants in taking an oath to avoid drugs and actively promote awareness about their ill effects. The event concluded with the distribution of certificates, AICTE activity points, and refreshments to all volunteers, recognizing their efforts and commitment to the cause. This impactful initiative successfully inspired the participants and the public to contribute towards building a drug-free society.
