HISTORY OF INDEPENDENCE DAY

Republic Day, celebrated on January 26, marks the day when India became a sovereign republic in 1950 by adopting its Constitution. The date was intentionally chosen to honor the historic resolution of Purna Swaraj passed on January 26, 1930, declaring India's intent for complete independence. Following independence in 1947, the drafting committee, led by Dr. B.R. Ambedkar, worked meticulously for nearly three years to frame the Constitution, which replaced the Government of

India Act, 1935. This day signifies the birth of the world's largest democracy and is a reminder of the values of liberty, justice, and equality enshrined in the Constitution. Republic Day celebrations reflect national pride, cultural diversity, and the sacrifices that paved the way for India's freedom and self-governance.

SCOPE OF THE PROGRAM

The 76th Republic Day was celebrated with great enthusiasm by all the students. On this occasion, the NSS Unit of KSIT took the initiative in organizing the event. President Sri R.
