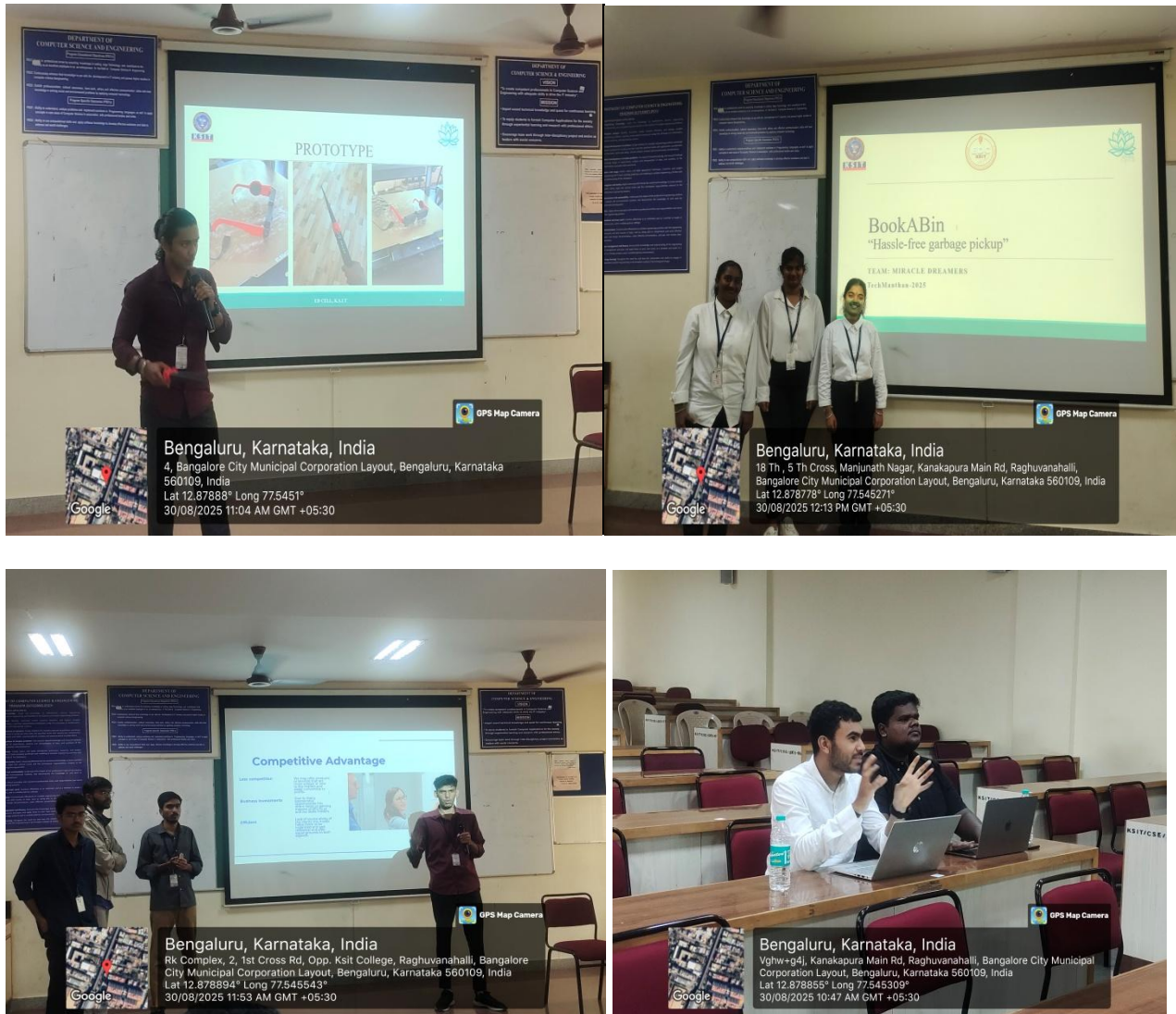


Inaugural function

The event began with a formal inaugural function in the presence of faculty members, coordinators, and students.

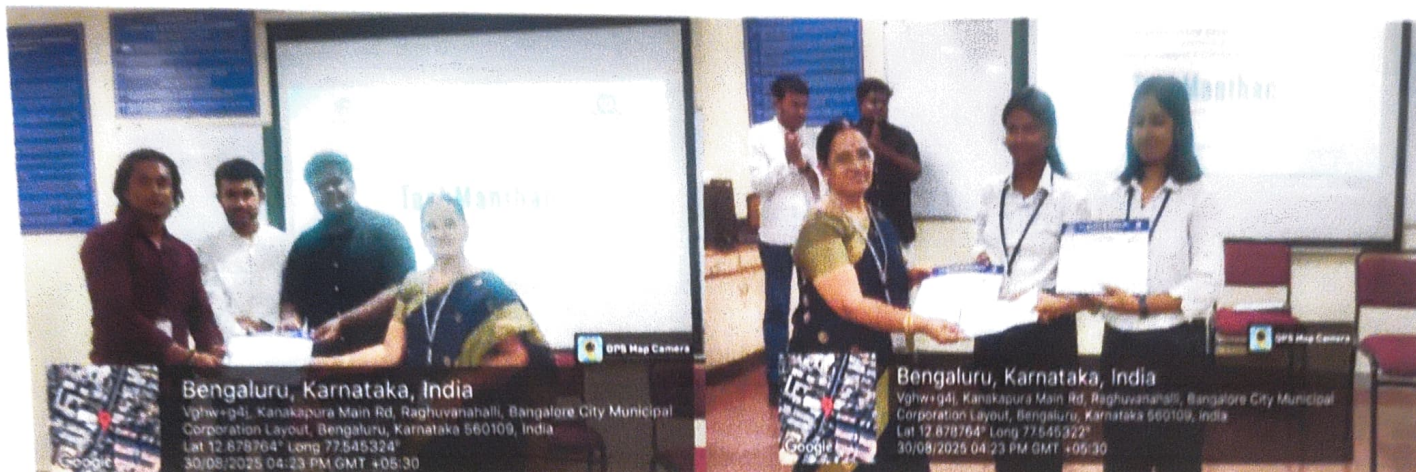
